- 1. Welcome Paul Haack, VP of Competition, presided over the meeting.
- 2. Introductions of RCDs.
- 3. Approval of April Meeting Minutes.
- 4. VP Comments
 - a. Agenda Review
 - b. Meeting format and ground rules.
 - c. HS and Novice Cards didn't grab any.
 - d. E-Board Updates For insurance purposes, NCCC will not allow any Primary Non Contributing Insurance Rider/Waiver. The short of it, when a venue requests this Rider/Waiver, NCCC takes full responsibility at event. Our insurance takes the full hit and blame should an accident happen. Further description will be available at the Regional Governors Meeting.
- 5. Top 5 men no men. Top 5 women J. Ruston #5. Top 5 clubs OCCC 3rd.
- 6. 2013 event review 1492 or so sanctions/events in competition database, 947 results in database.
- 7. Record Drag index updates will be required before Oklahoma City, will probably nto get until the week before since there are record drags in West Region on October 5 or 6.
- 8. Record Drag events October in West Region and Oklahoma at Thunder Valley.
- 9. Convention discussion for 2013 It was mentioned that Tech went well and events went well.
- 10. Clarifications None.
- 11. Several discussions occurred over the rule book change package to be presented to the National Governors for vote in November.
 - a. Novice passengers this did not change, will be part of package. Would allow an experienced driver to ride with a novice or allow novice to ride with an experienced driver.
 - b. Reduce passenger minimum age this did not change, will be part of package. Minimum age reduced to 12 years old. Passenger below 16 must be a relative. This would still depend on if club/event wants to allow passengers during their event.
 - c. Take maps off of flyers this did not change, will be part of package. This is to allow some simplification of the flyer, either a map or written directions to event site.
 - d. Revisions to classes this was reviewed and altered. Later this week the VP of Comp said he would post his presentation, I will provide when provided to me. Classes recommended for restructure, go from 43 to 22 classes. Removes Group 1, combines F and G with H into one class, C6 basically the same. Back dating and updating along with air box changes and shift kits were left in 1S change.
 - e. High Speed certification process - this did not change, will be part of package Group decided to recommend raising requirement for new certifications to 40 events over 5 weekends. Taking a school is preferred method.

- 12. Competition database Updates continue for the database. There are still some lessons being learned. Results for example.
- 13. Note for regional drag standings, the Matching Times event is not shown with the drag racing, it currently shows in the autocross listing. I have an update that includes the points for the MT Drag for Drag standings. I have not backed them out of the Autocross points. The fix has been requested from the Database Administrator.
