Cowtown Vettes Valve Cover Drag Racing 2026 Rules and Information

You can either build your own Valve Cover Drag car or use one of the club's cars. If the number of participants exceeds the number of available club cars, sharing will be necessary, and you may need to switch cars between races. A coin flip will determine whether the current vehicle is kept or changed.

RULES for the Valve Cover Drag Racing Car (from 2025 NCCC Convention)

- The valve cover must be from a Chevy Small or Big Block V8 and must be identifiable as a valve cover.
- Maintain the factory gasket edge sealing surface.
- It can have a chassis, but nothing may extend beyond the gasket surface in front of the car.
- The centerline of the rear wheels may not extend beyond the gasket surface at the rear of the car.
- **WHEELS:** There are a maximum of 4 wheels, either inside or outside of the valve cover, just not in front of the car. Wheels must be non-metallic (like skate wheels).
- Power: Gravity-powered only; no motors, springs, external propulsion, or moving weights.
- Must be clean (no sludge, dripping oil or grease)
- Dimensions
 - Max Length = 26"
 - Max Width = 10"
 - Max Height = 9"
 - Max wheel diameter - 4"
 - Max weight = 8 lbs (official digital scallions at the event will govern)
 - Minimum ½" clearance to the bottom of the race car

Track Description (the track details may change as it is still being built and tested)

- Lanes are 11" wide, with a 2" tall border on the outside to hold your car in place.
- The starting section will be a 10' Section at about 40 degrees down to the level section of the track
- The Level Section will be wood or may roll out to the floor to extend the track further, but will still have border.
- There is a drag racing tree to start the race:
 - Button to stage press and HOLD. Once both are staged, 2nd light will light and start the race
 - 3 yellow lights, then a Green Light
 - After the green light, release the button to release your car.
 - If you release too soon, you will be red-lighted and will not start your car. (or 15?sec penalty release your car 15 sec after the green light?)
- Sensor at the end to determine the winner (1" above the track)

EVENTS and scoring

- Valve Cover People's Choice Judging
 - This will be part of a Chance Rallye.
 - Voting takes place before the start of and or during racing (Can not vote on your own car)
 - NCCC Scoring will be based on adding your Driver and Navigators score together and scored in the Rallye Classes (tie breakers will be high card A's are high)
- Drag Race
 - This will be done as a Funkhana. All Drivers and Navigators will get into the team's Corvette when the whistle blows, get out, and go line up. This will help start the lineup of racing.
 - You will race others in a round robin, random style.
 - Entrants will stage their own cars on the track
 - The winner is the First car to cross the finish line.
 - Win the race, and you get 1 point; lose the race, and you get 0 points.
 - Everyone will race the same number of times, about 8 times, depending on the number of people.
 - Will add your team's Driver and Navigators Score together to get the Team's score.
 - The tiebreaker will be a Brack-style race for the teams tied. They will choose the car and driver.
 - For NCCC Points, standard Funkhana Classes will be scored on teams.
