

This is proposal to setup a system of PERMANENT COMPETITION NUMBERS for competitors in the Southwest region.

The numbers would range from 200 through 999 inclusive. The numbers from 1 through 199 inclusive would be available at each event for competitors to use that have not applied for a permanent number.

Requests for numbers would be accepted on a first come/first served basis throughout the year based on when the request is received by the 'Number Keeper'. All requests would be made by mail, e-mail or in person to the 'Number Keeper'. In any case, the request would be submitted on the OFFICIAL NUMBER FORM. NO PHONE REQUESTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

All numbers are considered permanent until requested otherwise. A periodic review will be done to determine if numbers are still being used.

All requests would be subject to verification. In other words, if a request is submitted at an event for a number and the same number is requested by mail by someone else which arrives before the event, the mailed request would have first consideration.

The numbering system would allow the 'regular' competitors to put numbers on their cars in a more permanent and LEGIBLE manner than is currently afforded by shoe polish, making timing and scoring a lot easier.

Permanent numbers would be put, at a minimum, on each side of the car, on the body (door, fender, etc). Numbers may be put on side windows ONLY IF THE WINDOWS ARE TINTED.

The use of number plates for cars with no side glass (Race Prepared, etc) would allowed as long as number height requirements are met.

Numbers would be a minimum of 6 inches high and of a color that contrasts with the surrounding body panel. Numbers should be in 'Block Style'. However, variations in script type will be allowed as long as it is legible to the common man. The idea is that the number can be read from about 75 feet while the car is moving rapidly by timing or corner workers.

This system can be made to work. I will be glad to administer the number system unless someone else has a burning desire to do so.

I have enclosed a sample number form to be used to submit number requests.
